Performance Evidence

The candidate must be assessed on their ability to integrate and apply the performance requirements of this unit in a workplace setting. Performance must be demonstrated consistently over time and in a suitable range of contexts.

The candidate must provide evidence that they can:

- mark out a site for timber structures and features according to design drawings and specifications
- apply a variety of surface finishes
- establish levels and prepare footings where required
- estimate quantities
- use levelling equipment
- excavate footings
- fix, join or assemble timbers using a variety of recognised methods
- use a power tools efficiently and safely

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- the principles and practices for erecting timber structures
- common timber joins
- levelling principles and techniques
- footings for timber structures and their construction methods
- timber fixing methods and products
- timber properties and characteristics

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy current standards for RTOs.
