## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- interpret music publishing briefs
- prepare different types of compositions for publishing, including one that has parts
- notate and proofread music for publication
- evaluate own work and identify ways to improve

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

## Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain publishers' requirements in relation to notation of music
- explain musical protocols and customs for notating and editing music for publication
- describe features of a range software tools/packages and other resources that might be required for notating music for publication
- explain file formats that might be used for publishing music
- describe copyright issues and intellectual property rights in the context of preparing compositions for publishing
- outline issues and challenges that typically arise in the context of preparing compositions for publishing, and how they might be overcome.

## Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- opportunities for preparing compositions for publishing

- printed scores or recorded performances.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
