Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and on at least one occasion:

- apply legislation, policy and guidelines relating to resource usage, storage and maintenance
- communicate with others on resource related matters, including maintenance contractors, work unit members and managers
- monitor outcomes of resource usage and impact on work unit goals.

Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- legislation, policies, procedures and guidelines relating to resource usage and the workplace
- operational procedures for accessing, storing, maintaining and using resources
- evidence-based decision-making processes
- security and fraud control guidelines
- stock handling procedures.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure access to:

- legislation, policies, procedures and guidelines relating to resource usage, storage and maintenance
- workplace systems and technology for resource ordering, management and financial requirements.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
