- MEM18055 Dismantle, replace and assemble engineering components.

- semi-automatic and automatic machines of a stand-alone, continuous production or process nature

Checks include one (1) or more of the following:

- programmed safety and maintenance checks
- adjustments of a limited nature, including:
 - safety guards

This field allows for different work environments and conditions that may affect performance. Essential operating conditions that may be present (depending on the work situation, accessibility of the item, and local industry and regional contexts) are included.

- stops
- wear pads and tool holders
- nipping up glands
- adjustment of scrappers and aprons

Consumable components include one (1) or more of the following:

- air filters
- oil wipers
- grease containers
- tool tips
- indicator globes
- fluids and lubricants
- guides
- limit switch actuators
